



The Vocational training campus

The future **Regional vocational training campus** is tasked with **meeting the employment needs of companies** by giving young people the opportunity to enter the workforce **through sandwich courses, vocational training and career advice.**



Co-championed by the CCI and Habitat 06, the Regional Vocational Training Campus will be based in the Nice Méridia joint development zone and will have facilities to train 2,000 students

- from vocational qualifications to engineering degrees
- Company services
- Family accommodation
- An event venue
- Flats for those on sandwich courses

The variety of programmes will make it possible to **share the facilities** while ensuring **compatibility in the way it is used** and encourage the rapid, organised development of a learning environment.



Partner schools represented will be as follows:

- The Centre des Études Supérieures Industrielles (CESI)**
A general engineering and IT school, mainly focused on energy efficiency and sustainable development. CESI is ranked 3rd among engineering schools for creating the most startups in France
- L'institut de Formation Automobile (IFA),**
- L'Institut de Formation Pharmacie Santé (IFPS),**
- NEGOVENTIS**, managed by the CCI, which offers sales training programmes (2 years of higher education).

The building will make use of all available **eco-construction methods** that can be reasonably implemented. In addition to the project's expected benefits, **the aim is to raise public awareness of sustainable development through being exemplary.** 100 places will be reserved for **a training incubator.**

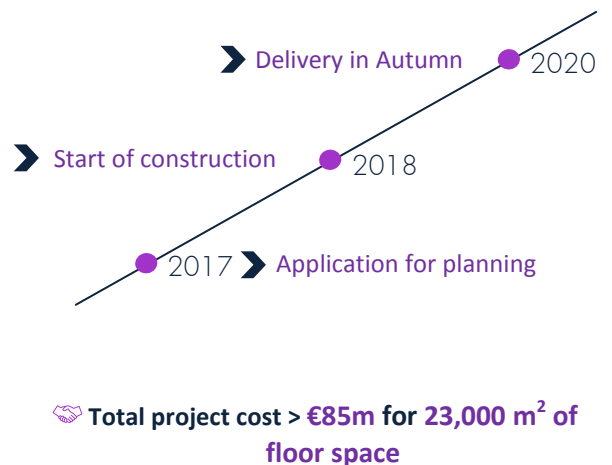
