



Pasteur centre Towards a European City of Health

Over the next 20 years, the European City of Health aims to develop **projects which both improve the health and quality of life of local residents, and stimulate economic development and research**. Its location within the Pasteur district and the eponymous hospital, is also play a role in regenerating the eastern part of Nice.

The European City of Health comprises **10 short and medium-term projects**, managed by the services of Nice City Council and the Metropole, the University and CCAS as well as other support services. These ten projects **are based on a favourable ecosystem of the local demography** (high number of old people), **the importance of tourism and the momentum around the Smart and Connected City**.
