The Metropole Nice Côte d'Azur holds the chair of the Euromed cities network. This network, created in 2000, as part of the Barcelona Process, brings together a hundred cities from Europe and the southern and eastern banks of the Mediterranean, representing 27 countries

The members of the Euromed cities network develop exchange experiences, multilateral and bilateral cooperation, particularly economic, especially for Euro-Mediterranean issues related to:

- 👽 youth employment,
- tackling climate change and its consequences.
- business sectors for the cities

Since June 2015, the following cooperation areas have been launched:

9 European MED Interreg programme

Leader of a strategic coordination and decision-aid project in the field of energy-efficient public buildings, in a Mediterranean region from Portugal to Cyprus.

- The Horizon 2020 European research programme: Partner in an experimental project aimed at finding a biological solution to treat Xylella fastidiosa, the bacteria which kills olive trees.
- European pilot project for youth employment in the Mediterranean basin: initiative brought before the European Parliament.
- Feconomic and technical cooperation with the City of Nuremberg, the city of Genoa, the Centre de Formation et d'Appui à la Décentralisation de Tunisie et Cités Unies Liban.
