

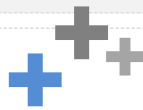


MIN – A new agri-food platform

The Metropolis Nice Cote d'Azur manages the **Market of National Importance (MIN) of Nice**. The aim of the Nice MIN is to help **organise and improve productivity of the wholesale food and horticultural distribution channels**, by **creating competition** in these economic sectors and contributing to the **food security of communities**.

The MIN represents a significant economic activity for the Metropole, with a **cumulative, total turnover of wholesale trade of approximately €270m and more than 800 direct jobs**.

The Metropole is committed to relocating this facility to the town of La Gaude, as part of creating **an agricultural platform** bringing together, in addition to the future MIN, the headquarters of the Chamber of Agriculture of the Alpes-Maritimes, the Mediterranean agricultural research and experimentation centre (CREAM) and a specific property development programme for agro-food and distribution.
